The Council seeks to create an accountable and effective structure for interagency collaboration and to use federal authorities to promote family-sustaining careers and economic mobility for low-income Americans. The information gathered in response to the RFI will be used to better inform the Council's priorities, working group activities and products, stakeholder engagement, and federal programs. Feedback on the specific economic mobility, recovery, and resilience challenges in communities in the short, medium, and long term is welcome.
