- Complete online Application Form
- Have your dissertation advisor complete the online Recommendation Form
- Deadline is February 1, 2023

LOGISTICS OF THE APPLICATION PROCESS Timeline

- February 1, 2023: Application Deadline
- Early March 2023: Notification of acceptance
- May 22-26: Workshop dates

- Chance to apply for a \$5,000 student research award
